## **Cancer treatment discovery**

**A ground-breaking treatment for bowel cancer has been discovered which may improve survival rates for patients, research has found. Researchers at Queen's University in Belfast have unearthed a therapeutic process that targets and kills bowel cancer cells. The research, which has been published in**

**the journal of Molecular Cancer Therapeutics, is believed to be the first of its kind. The discovery was led by Dr Nicholas Forsythe, Professor Sandra Van Schaeybroeck and the late Professor Patrick Johnston. Professor Van Schaeybroeck said the study was "good news" for certain bowel cancer patients here and abroad.**
